### PARENT REMINDERS

**SICKNESS:** Please remember to not send your child to school if he/she has a fever, coloured discharge, is coughing a lot or has been sick vomiting or has had diarrhea in the past 48 hours. Also if your child has a communicable disease we require that you notify the school about it.



**HAND SANITIZER:** We ask that parents do not send hand sanitizer in their children's snack containers. Due to the children's ages, the teachers administer it.

**SNACK TIME:** There is to be NO pop sent for snack time. Also, foods with choking hazards such a cherry tomatoes and grapes need to be cut into quarters. If you do not pack your child's snack, please communicate this to whoever prepares the snack.

**INDOOR SHOES:** If you forget to bring your child's indoor shoes, we have some extra shoes to borrow or you can clean off their boots and they can wear their boots in school.
