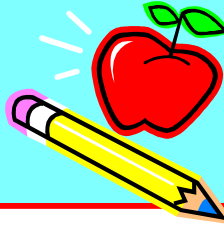

PARENT REMINDERS

SICKNESS: Please remember to not send your child to school if he/she has a fever, coloured discharge, is coughing a lot or has been sick vomiting or has had diarrhea in the past 48 hours. Also if your child has a communicable disease we require that you notify the school about it.



STARTING SCHOOL: Please remember to wait in the coatroom until the teachers come to say it is time instead of waiting at their door. The exception to this is classes that start in the Gym.

Parents & caregivers are required to take the child right to the classroom door and see him/her enter at drop off before leaving.

SNACK TIME: There is to be no pop or candy and **NO NUT PRODUCTS** sent for snack time. Also, foods with choking hazards such a cherry tomatoes and grapes need to be cut into quarters. If you do not pack your child's snack, please communicate this to whoever prepares the snack.

INDOOR SHOES: If you forget to bring your child's indoor shoes, we have some extra shoes to borrow. They are located behind the bathroom doors of both boys and girls bathroom's. Please return them where you got them from when your child is finished class. We do not allow stocking feet or bare feet at school. You can also leave your child's shoes in the cubbie. Make sure you label your child's name on the shoes.
